G O. (P) No. 405/2013/Fin. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 27th August, 2013.

S. R. O. No. 678/2013.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Service Rules, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Service (Sixth Amendment) Rules, 2013.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of February, 2011.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In the Kerala Service Rules, in Appendix VII, under the heading, ‘Section II-Special Casual Leave,’ after rule 19, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“(20) Every employee having a physically or mentally challenged child shall be granted special casual leave for a maximum period of 15 days in a calendar year on production of a certificate from a medical officer attending the child, stating that the child is physically, or mentally, challenged, on each occasion of the leave. Special casual leave under this rule shall be granted on more than one occasion subject to a maximum period of 15 days in a calendar year, if found necessary. The leave may be combined with ordinary leave or casual leave and the period of leave shall be exclusive of public holidays that may intervene. If both the parents are Government employees, a declaration countersigned by the competent authority to the effect that the spouse has not availed the leave in that calendar year shall also be produced.”.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per G. O. (P) No. 333/2011/Fin. dated 6th August, 2011, the Government have ordered that employees having physically or mentally challenged children will be granted special casual leave for a maximum period of 15 days in a calendar year on production of certificate from a medical officer attending them. In order to give statutory validity to the said Government order, the Government have decided to amend the Kerala Service Rules.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
