1. Verification and sanction by the Head of

Department at District Level : Upto Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand only)

2. Prior verification by the District Medical Officer Concerned and sanction by the Head of the

Department at District Level : From Rs. 10,000/- to Rs. 1 Lakhs

3. Prior verification by the Director of Health Services/Director Indian System of Medicine

And sanction by the Head of Department : Above Rs. 1 Lakhs

The above delegation and ceiling limit for reimbursement is for the treatment undergone at Government Hospitals alone.
