ORDER

According to Government Decision No. 2 below Rule 33, Part I, Kerala Service Rules, provisional service on regularisation or followed by regular appointment with or without break in the same category of post will be treated as officiating service *ab initio* for the limited purpose of granting of increment subject to the conditions stated therein. The above decision was taken at a time when provisional employees were eligible for increments. But in the Government Orders read, Rule 9 (a) (i), Part II of Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules was amended making provisional employees ineligible for increments with effect from 1-8-1986. Hence there is no longer any reason to count their provisional service for increment on regular appointment.

Government have examined the matter in detail and have decided to discontinue the practice of granting increments to employees reckoning provisional service on getting regular appointment. In order to obviate the hardship that may be caused to employees who are already enjoying this benefit, the decision will have only prospective effect. The provisional hands, temporarily appointed under Rule 9 (a) (i) of Part II, Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958, who get regular appointment with or without break on or after 1-10-1994 or whose provisional service gets regularised with effect from 1-10-1994 or thereafter, will not be eligible for increments reckoning their provisional service. Accordingly, the following orders are issued:
