ORDER

The freedom fighters and their dependants are eligible for free medical attendance and the expenditure on this account is reimbursed as per the guidelines issued in government orders read as ist and 2nd papers above. It has further been ordered that the medical officer in charge of the institution where treatment is taken will draw and disburse the expenses met by the freedom fighters. The Sree Chitra Thirunal Institute of Medical Science and Technology, Thiruvananthapuram is an approved institution for treatment of state freedom fighters as per GO dated 26-3-1993. But there is no specific procedure to be followed for claiming medical expenses incurred for the treatment of freedom fighters at Sree Chitra Thirunal Institute Thiruvananthapuram.

Government are therefore pleased to order that the superintendent of the district hospitals will be the authority to draw and disburse the medical expenses incurred by the freedom fighters for their treatment in Sree Chitra Thirunal Institute Thiruvananthapuram. The bills have to be produced by them before the concerned superintendent of the district Hospitals. The expenditure on this account will be met from the provisions under “Other Charges “ of the budget allotment of the concerned District Hospitals.
