**ORDER**

The time limit for crediting arrears of DA to the PF Account of the employees sanctioned as per GO read as 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> papers above, were extended vide GO read as 9<sup>th</sup> paper above and the extended time limit expired on 29<sup>th</sup> February 2012. Similarly the arrears of DA sanctioned as per G.O read as 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> paper above can be drawn and credited to the PF account of the employee along with the salary bill only upto October 2011 and May 2012 respectively.

Several requests are being received from various Heads of Institutions and individuals seeking extension of time for crediting the arrears of DA to the PF account for the period from 01.01.2008 onwards.

Government have examined the requests and are pleased to order that the time limit for crediting the arrears of DA sanctioned from 01/01/2008, 01/07/2008, 01/01/2009, 01/07/2009, 01/01/2010, 01/07/10, 1/1/2011 & 1/7/2011 to the PF Account of employees will be extended for 6 months. The DA arrears can be claimed in the salary bill upto 31<sup>st</sup> January 2013 and credited to PF

Account without fail. Further chance for crediting the arrears of Dearness Allowance sanctioned upto 01/07/2008 will not be allowed.

All controlling officers will adhere to the time schedule invariably.
